Two new schemes have started:


London North-Central & EastNorth-East England

UKPHR's register has been accredited by PSA CPD scheme for practitioners launched UKPHR has moved - London to Birmingham New staff in post, new website and IT system

Public Health Register

UKPHR and AVR

Accredited Voluntary Register is a quality assured standard awarded by Professional Standards Authority

UKPHR achieved the standard in April 2014

It was a tough process

Annual renewal has to be sought and justified





Public Health Register

UKPHR and CPD

Continuing Professional Development is a professional and ethical requirement

UKPHR requires Specialist registrants to meet the Faculty's CPD standard (50 credits a year) or equivalent

UKPHR has now introduced a CPD standard for Practitioner registrants (75 hours over 5 years)





Public Health Register

UKPHR and Revalidation

UKPHR/FPH scheme to revalidate Specialist registrants

Until implemented, UKPHR will continue to require 5-yearly re-registration appraisal, personal development planning and participation in approved CPD system

Revalidation will extend to Practitioner registrants
